## Home Solicitor Regulations

Residents should be aware of the rules when door-to-door solicitors come knocking. The following regulations help protect the public from unwanted disruptions and from those who would use solicitation as a front for criminal activity:

1. Solicitors selling goods or services must register their activities with the City and obtain a permit.
2. Solicitors must disclose and show their City permit if requested to do so.
3. All solicitors must obey “no solicitor” and “no trespassing” signage and must conduct their activities between 9:00 am and 9:00 pm.

If solicitation activities are suspicious, please contact City Hall or during non-business hours contact the non-emergency dispatch number, 503-434-6500.

## Community Clean-up Day

Mark your calendars for our annual Clean-up Day on Saturday May 18th, from 8:00 am to noon. Disposal and recycling containers will be set up behind City Hall, at 486 Third Street. This event is for Lafayette residents only and photo identification is required.

Items that will be accepted include:

- Household appliances that have never contained Freon/refrigerant
- Automotive and rechargeable batteries
- Electronics: computers, laptops, TVs, monitors, printers, and related technology
- Household furniture
- Scrap metal

## Level I Water Use to Begin on June 4, 2019

Lafayette water customers will begin an odd/even water use schedule on June 4th. The Level I watering is an odd/even schedule based on the address of your water service. Odd-numbered addresses use outside water on odd-numbered calendar days, and even-numbered addresses use water on even-numbered calendar days. This proscriptive measure will help to postpone or eliminate the need for a higher level of water curtailment that may be needed later in the summer to meet daily peak demands.

Lafayette voters in May 2018 approved a project to install a water intertie with McMinnville Water & Light. This project is on track to deliver water in time for the summer of 2020. Please conserve water, observe the odd/even use schedule, and help our community manage summer demand with limited water resources.

## Graffiti Vandalism Enforcement

If you see graffiti or vandalism in your neighborhood, on public or private property, please report it immediately to City Hall at 503-864-2451. City crews will attempt to remove graffiti from City property within 24 hours of receiving a report. Private property owners will be notified of graffiti or vandalism on their property and of their responsibility to remove it. Assistance may be available for graffiti removal on private property. If you observe graffiti or vandalism in progress, call 503-464-6500 and report it immediately to the Yamhill County Sheriff's Department.

## Permit Required for All Fences

Prior to constructing a fence within the city limits, a permit must be obtained. The information you provide on the permit application helps staff to verify that the fence meets all zoning and structural code requirements. In most instances, there is no fee for the permit. Permit applications are available at City Hall. If you have additional questions, please contact City staff at 503-864-2451.
