## Back to School

Our children are back at school, which means it's time for drivers to pay more attention. When traveling through neighborhoods, please watch for kids as they make their way to and from the various bus stops.

Please observe the following guidelines:

- **Wascher Parent drop-off:** The drop-off is located at the front of the building or at the playground. Students can go to the playground at 7:30 a.m. The playground will open at 7:30 a.m., as there will not be supervision before that time. The front doors will open at 7:55 a.m. If students arrive AFTER 7:55, please only drop them off in the front of the building, as there will not be supervision in the back.
- **Wascher Parent Drop-off and Pick-up:**
  - o During drop off and pick up, please:
    - ✦ Stay in your car. Wascher staff members will be present to assist with student safety at drop-off and pick-up times.
    - ✦ Drive slowly to keep students and other drivers safe.
    - ✦ Use the front lane to **drop off only**.
    - ✦ **Pick-up will ONLY be in the back of the building via the pick-up line at the end of the parking lot in the turnaround at the end of the day (2:30 pm).**
    - ✦ **The "No Left Turn" traffic changes from last year will remain in effect, please plan your route to and from the school accordingly.**
    - ✦ Always be mindful of the bus loading zone, and ensure space for the buses to enter and exit. School Doors open at 7:55 am for students, and school begins at 8:00 am.

## Update on Parking Ordinance Enforcement

The City of Lafayette would like to follow up with the community regarding **Lafayette Zoning and Development Ordinance 2.209.03**, regarding parking on front lawns is now being enforced. This decision was made by the Lafayette City Council on August 14, 2025, when they voted to uphold and enforce the ordinance as written, with no changes.

### Key Rules to Remember

#### Lafayette Zoning and Development Ordinance 2.209.03: No Parking in Front Yards

- Exclusive of driveways, no parking shall be allowed within the required front yard area or yards located adjacent to a street.
- The side yard and rear yard areas may be used for parking of vehicles unless otherwise prohibited by this ordinance.

The yard area adjacent to a street shall not be used for the permanent storage of utility trailers, house or vacation trailers, boats, or other similar vehicles.

#### Lafayette Municipal Code 6.105: Prohibited Parking and Standing

- **Trailers:** No trailer or semi-trailer shall be parked upon any residential public street for a period longer than four hours. An exception is made for a trailer transporting a boat or watercraft, which may be parked for up to 24 hours for purposes of loading, unloading, preparing for use, or preparing for storage.
- **Street Parking:** A vehicle may not be parked for more than 72 hours in one location on a public street, or for more than 72 hours within the same block or within 200 feet of any one parking location.
- **Recreational Vehicles (RVs):** A recreational vehicle is limited to a maximum of 24 hours of parking.

### Grace Period for Compliance

The City will provide fourteen days from the date the code enforcement warning was issued to find alternative parking or storage options for your vehicles.

## Bridge Street Construction

Construction for the Bridge Street repairs are projected to be within the window of August through October. The specific dates for construction are not set yet.

A draft traffic control plan has been developed that provides for one lane of traffic to be left open on Bridge Street at all times during construction. There will be traffic delays during construction.

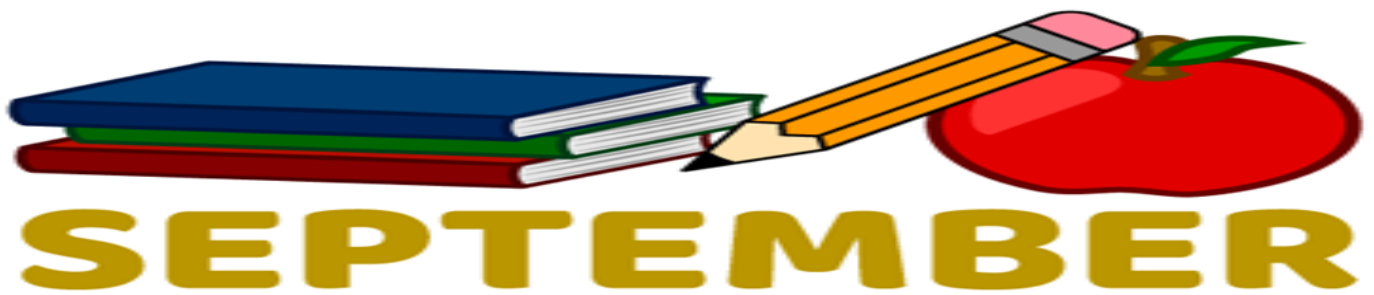
The work includes ADA ramps and pothole repairs, followed by the grind and inlay of Bridge Street between 4th and 12th Street.
